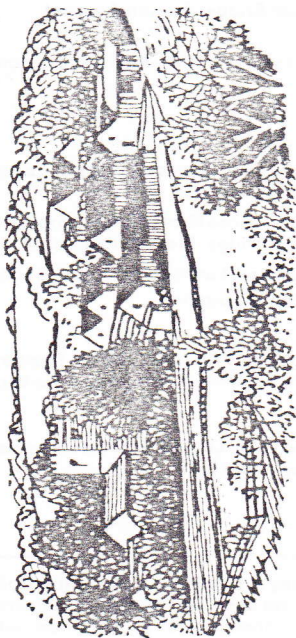




RAIL RAMBLERS

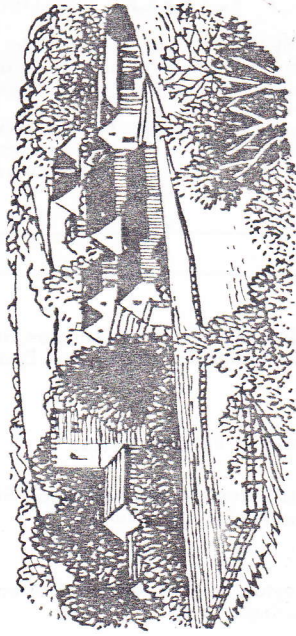
